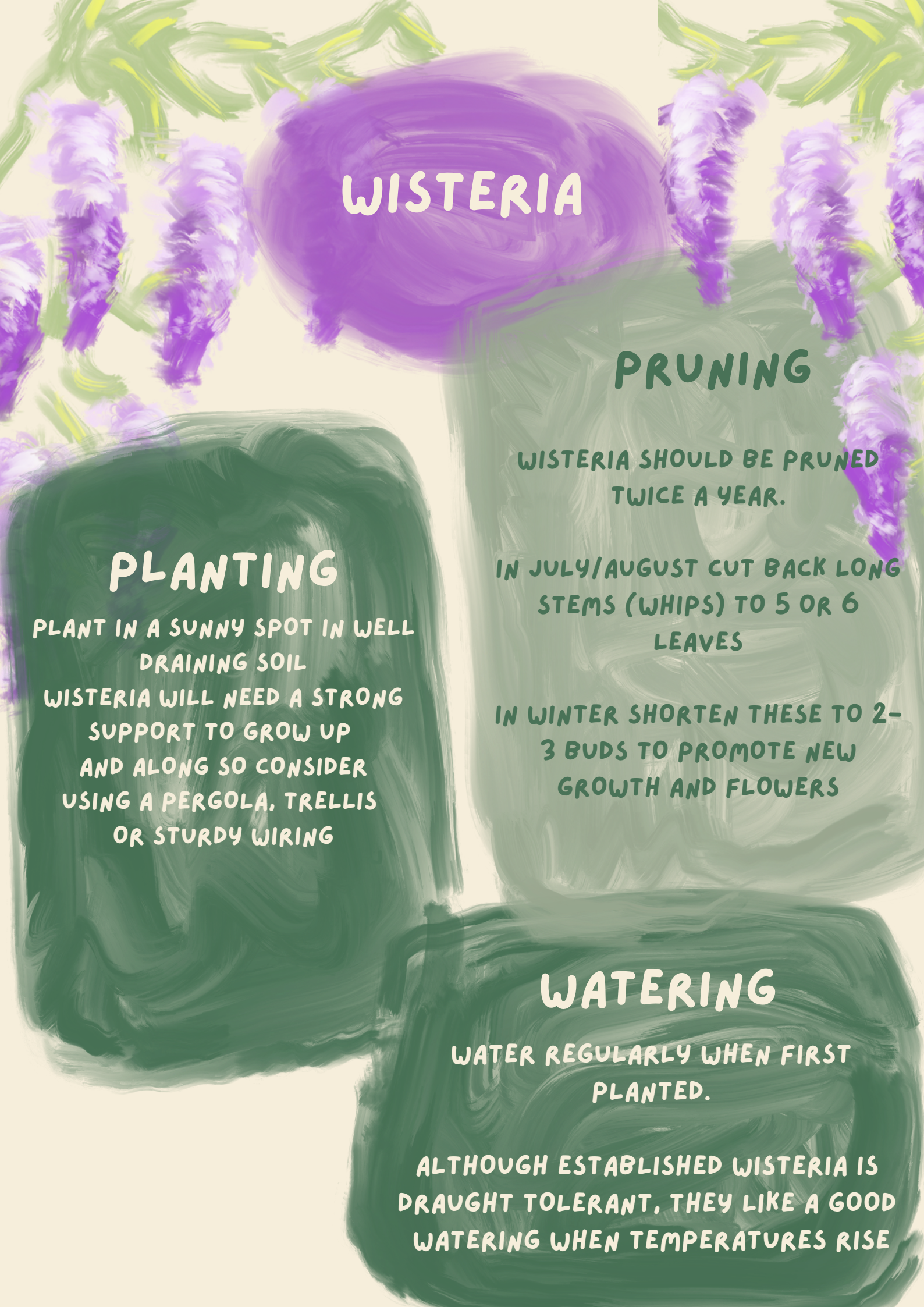




WISTERIA

PLANTING

PLANT IN A SUNNY SPOT IN WELL
DRAINING SOIL

WISTERIA WILL NEED A STRONG
SUPPORT TO GROW UP
AND ALONG SO CONSIDER
USING A PERGOLA, TRELLIS
OR STURDY WIRING

PRUNING

WISTERIA SHOULD BE PRUNED
TWICE A YEAR.

IN JULY/AUGUST CUT BACK LONG
STEMS (WHIPS) TO 5 OR 6
LEAVES

IN WINTER SHORTEN THESE TO 2-
3 BUDS TO PROMOTE NEW
GROWTH AND FLOWERS

WATERING

WATER REGULARLY WHEN FIRST
PLANTED.

ALTHOUGH ESTABLISHED WISTERIA IS
DRAUGHT TOLERANT, THEY LIKE A GOOD
WATERING WHEN TEMPERATURES RISE
