

ACER JAPANESE MAPLE

PLANTING

PLANT IN A DAPPLED OR PARTIALLY SHADED AND SHELTERED PLACE.

ACERS PREFER A SLIGHTLY ACIDIC SOIL, SO YOU COULD ADD SOME ERICACEOUS SOIL TO THE GROUND OR POT WHEN PLANTING

PRUNING

YOU WILL ONLY NEED TO LIGHTLY PRUNE AN ACER IN WINTER WHEN THE TREE IS DORMANT.

YOU CAN REMOVE ANY CROSSING BRANCHES TO RETAIN A NICE SHAPE AND ANY DEAD BRANCHES OR LEAVES

WATERING

ALWAYS KEEP THE SOIL MOIST, BUT NOT WATERLOGGED AS THIS CAN DAMAGE THE ROOT SYSTEM

KEEP AN EYE ON THE SOIL, IF IN A POT BECAUSE IT HAS A HABIT OF DRYING MUCH QUICKER.
